The Aliso Niguel High PTSA (ANHS PTSA) is pleased to offer **two scholarship programs** for graduating seniors. Each scholarship is to be used for continuing education, at a four-year college or university, a community college or a trade/technical school. The amount of each scholarship and the number of scholarships awarded will vary each year.

- This award especially recognizes **volunteer service** to ANHS and/or the wider community.
- Academic achievement and extracurricular involvement considered in the selection process.

TO APPLY

- Complete the following application. Please type or print legibly in black ink.
- Current membership in ANHS PTSA is required. Deadline for verification is February 13, 2013
- Application must be complete with all requested documentation.
- Parent or guardian must sign the application.
- Application must be turned in to the ANHS Guidance Office by March 15, 2013.

PAYMENT OF AWARD

- Recipients will be notified at the Senior Awards Ceremony in June 2013.
- The decision of the ANHS PTSA Scholarship committee is final.
- Official documentation of enrollment in a college, university or trade/technical school will be required to receive any award. (Costs associated with obtaining this documentation are the responsibility of the student. Many colleges/universities do charge a fee.)
- Contact information for the student and parent(s)/guardian(s) provided on the application will be used to update and notify students during the payment process.
- It is the responsibility of the student to make sure that ANHS PTSA has valid contact information.
- The ANHS PTSA reserves the right to revoke any scholarship award in the event the student does not maintain the required overall GPA, or if the student is subject to severe disciplinary action such as suspension or expulsion, or if the student fails to enroll in an eligible institution of higher education.
- The student must provide official documentation of enrollment by November 30, 2013 to receive their award.

The letter must be submitted to the committee, along with your application, **in a sealed envelope with the signature of the writer across the seal.**
